

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETINGS
OF THE CITY OF TARRANT, ALABAMA

HELD ON MONDAY, MARCH 16, 2020

The City Council of the City of Tarrant, Alabama met in regular session on the 16th day of March, 2020 at 7 pm in the Council Chambers at City Hall.

The following officials were present:

Horton moved, and Fields seconded the motion, to suspend the rules regarding the order of the established agenda for Tarrant City Council meetings and waive the reading in full of all items on the agenda. Upon roll call, all officials voted **AYE**.

Whereupon, Anderson moved, and Fields seconded the motion, to do the following:

- **Table Resolution No. 8641** to the next regularly scheduled council meeting
- **Amend Resolution No. 8642** so that Paragraph 2 will require bids to be returned by April 6th, 2020 at 10 am and publicly opened and read aloud at that time, instead of on April 2nd.
- **Amend Resolutions No. 8642 & 8643** to add Paragraph 4 that states “The Mayor, in the Mayor’s sole discretion, is authorized to extend the time for the return, opening, and reading of bids if necessary as the result of the COVID-19 outbreak or any other state of emergency declared by the Governor of Alabama,”
- **Add** to the agenda **Resolution No. 8646**, which approves a contract with Imperial Services for capping sewer service at properties to be demolished, and **Ordinance No. 1128**, which provides an emergency response to the COVID-19 outbreak.

Upon roll call, all officials voted **AYE**.

Whereupon, Bryant moved, and Anderson seconded the motion, to do the following:

- **Approve the minutes** as presented for the Pre-Council and Council meetings held on **March 2, 2020**
- **Adopt** as presented **Resolutions No. 8639, 8640, 8644, 8645 & 8646**
- **Adopt** amended **Resolutions No. 8642 & 8643**
- **Approve for payment of all vouchers & expenses** presented.

Upon roll call, all officials voted **AYE**.

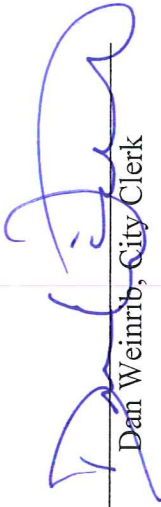
Whereupon, Fields moved for unanimous consideration of Ordinance No. 1128, which Horton seconded. Upon roll call, all officials voted **AYE**.
