

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TARRANT AMENDING
ORDINANCE NO. 1033, ARTICLE II. EXCAVATIONS AND CUTS,
SECTION 16-15, REQUIRING FEES FOR SQUARE FOOTAGE OF
STREET, CURB AND/OR SIDEWALK CUTS**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TARRANT THAT:

Section 1. That the Article II. Excavation and Cuts, Section 16-15 of Code of Ordinances of the

City of Tarrant be amended to read as follows:

(d) In addition to acquiring a permit, the permittee shall also pay an excavation & cut fee based on the following schedule:

Up to 75 SF	\$0
Over 75 SF	\$150 x [(X - 75 SF)/75]

ORDINANCE NO. 11040

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TARRANT AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 992, CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE VII, PURCHASING POLICY AND PROCEDURES TO PUT THE THRESHOLD FOR DIRECT PURCHASING BY CITY DEPARTMENTS IN SYNC WITH ALABAMA STATE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE DIVISION OF PURCHASING REGULATIONS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TARRANT THAT:

Section 1. That the Chapter 2, Article VII of Code of Ordinances of the City of Tarrant be amended

to read as follows:

Sec. 2-160. - Authorization limits.

- (a) Department heads have direct departmental purchasing authority for purchases up to \$1000.00.
- (b) Exceptions.
 - (1) Computers and related items. All purchases for computers, software and related items (printers, scanners, monitors, etc.) from all areas of the city must be processed through and approved by Information Technology Services (ITS).
 - (2) All purchases exceeding \$1000.00 must be submitted to the mayor's office on a purchase requisition form so that a purchase order can be issued.
 - (3) Exceptions to the \$1000.00 limit are reimbursements (expense and travel reimbursements), contract labor payments, payroll related disbursements, fund transfers, BOE payments, debt services, repetitive monthly expenses not under contract (expense varies monthly and the amount is not known in advance).

Sec. 2-161. - Approval process.

- (a) *Expenditures not exceeding \$1000.00.* The department head shall approve the expense by utilizing the accounting stamp issued and inserting the necessary information. The department head's signature for approval is required.
- (b) *Expenditures exceeding \$1000.00.* The department head will approve a completed purchase requisition form and forward it to the mayor for approval. The purchase requisition form is the authorization to initiate the procurement process; it enables the purchase order and/or agreement to be generated and provides the information to enter into the purchase order system.

Sec. 2-180. - Direct voucher payment.

Office of administrative responsibility: Department head.

Approver: Department head and mayor.

Scope: Compliance with the city procedures.

Extends to all employees of the city.

A direct voucher payment should be used for subscriptions, postal requests, consultants/services, utilities, insurance, memberships, professional fees and unauthorized purchases (purchases made that bypass the mayor's office). Unauthorized purchases consist of supplies/services exceeding \$1000.00 that

were purchased without a purchase order or proper bidding. Unauthorized purchases must be accompanied by a detailed explanation of the reason for said purchase.

Sec. 2-181. - Purchase requisition form procedure.

Office of administrative responsibility: Department head.

Approver: Department head and mayor.

Scope: Compliance with the city procedure.

Extends to all employees of the city.

The purchase requisition form should fully describe what is being purchased; quantity of items and/or term of contract; description of commodities or services required; street address where items are to be delivered or services are to be performed; notation of urgency or deadlines; justification for the purchase; commodities such as equipment should indicate the model number and a brief description of the equipment (also indicate the property number to be assigned to the equipment).

Purchases in excess of \$1000.00 require the approval of a purchase requisition form and a standard purchase order to be issued prior to authorizing the purchase of materials, services, etc.

(a) Submit a completed purchase requisition form to the mayor clearly indicating the goods and/or services to be purchased (both quantity and dollar amount). The purchase requisition form must include:

- (1) Date.
- (2) Vendor name and address (vendor number if known).
- (3) Purchase description (quantity, description and unit cost).
- (4) Complete account code, including fund number.
- (5) Bill to and shipping address.
- (6) Expected delivery date.
- (7) Requisitions for registration fees should include the attendee's name and date of event.
- (b) A minimum of two telephone quotations or written quotations shall be obtained and attached to requisitions for purchases costing \$1000.00 up to and including \$15,000.00. When circumstances do not allow obtaining the telephone or written quotations a letter of justification from the requestor must be attached to the purchase requisition. In the event the mayor determines that the letter of justification is insufficient, quotes will be required.
- (c) Resolution number and bid should be referenced if applicable.
- (d) The purchase requisition form is the authorization to initiate the procurement process; it provides the necessary information to be entered into the purchase order system and it enables a purchase order to be generated.
- (e) If a purchase is made by requesting a check to prepay for an item, the receipt of items purchased must be forwarded to the accounts payable department, in order to complete the accounting process.
- (f) A purchase requisition in excess of the competitive bid threshold will be subject to the competitive bid process.
- (g) An invoice relative to a purchase order must have the associated purchase order number listed on the invoice and also must be approved by the appropriate department head prior to being paid.
- (h) Any revisions/corrections to purchase orders must be done by way of a change order request.

Sec. 2-184. - Purchase order procedure.

Office of administrative responsibility: Department head.

Approver: Department head and mayor.

Scope: Compliance with the city procedure.

Extends to all employees of the city.

Purchases in excess of \$1000.00 require a standard purchase order to be issued prior to authorizing the purchase of materials, services, etc.

(a) Submit a completed purchase requisition form to the mayor clearly indicating the goods and/or services to be purchased and the estimated annual usage (both quantity and dollar amount). The purchase requisition form must include:

- (1) Date.
- (2) Vendor name and address (vendor number if known).

- (3) Purchase description (quantity, description and unit cost).
- (4) Complete account code, including fund number.
- (5) Bill to and shipping address.
- (6) Expected delivery date.
- (7) Resolution number and bid should be referenced if applicable.
- (b) The purchase requisition form is the authorization to initiate the procurement process; it provides the necessary information to be entered into the purchase order system and it enables a purchase order to be generated.
- (c) If a purchase is made by requesting a check to prepay for an item, the receipt of items purchased must be forwarded to the accounts payable department, in order to clear the prepaid from the accounting system.
- (d) A purchase requisition form in excess of the competitive bid threshold will be subject to the competitive bid process.
- (e) An invoice relative to a purchase order must have the associated purchase order number listed on the invoice and also must be approved by the appropriate department head prior to being paid.
- (f) Purchase order increases. The originator must create an additional purchase requisition form for any difference between the original requisition and the increased amount. The new purchase requisition form should reference the original purchase order number created by the initial purchase requisition form, line item being increased and an explanation of the increase. This would apply to minor changes for a total monetary amount less than that required for competitive bidding.
- (g) Purchase order decreases. The originator must notify accounts payable in writing when a purchase order is complete and falls short of the original amount. Accounts payable will close out the purchase order. The final invoice should note that the purchase order is complete.

Section 2. That in future years the threshold for direct departmental purchasing authority shall be set by Chapter 4 – Purchasing Procedures and Documents section of the Fiscal Procedures Manual, as promulgated by the Alabama Department of Finance, or any successor state purchasing regulations.

RESOLUTION NO. 8410

ENDORISING STATE HIGHWAY 79 PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City of Tarrant (the "City") is desirous of having certain improvements made on Alabama State Highway 79 ("SR-79") within the City limits in accordance with plans prepared by the Alabama Department of Transportation ("ADOT") and designated as Project Number: NH-0079(518) Resurface, Plane, Stripe, Level and Patch on SR-79 to Cedar Street in Birmingham MP 0.345 to 2.045; and

WHEREAS, the ADOT is now or may later be desirous of receiving federal aid for improvement of said highway; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Highway Administration, an agency of the United States of America, ("FHA") will not participate in any funding for the construction of said project until and unless the City will agree to certain requirements of the FHA. The City for the purpose of complying with requirements of the FHA in regard to its funding of improvements of the type and kind in this agreement provided for, does hereby pass and adopt the following resolution.

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Tarrant, Alabama while in regular session on Wednesday, January 3, 2018 at 7:00 pm as follows:

Section 1. That the plans of said project including alignment, profile, grades, typical sections and paving layouts as submitted to this City and which are now on file in the office of City Clerk are approved and that the location of said project as staked out by the ADOT, in cooperation with the FHA, is hereby authorized to proceed with the grading, draining, paving and otherwise improving and construction of said project in accordance with said plans; and

Section 2. That the City hereby grants to the ADOT the full use of and access to the dedicated widths of any existing streets for the construction of said project and hereby agrees to permit and allow the ADOT to close and barricade the said project and intersecting streets for as long as necessary while the said project is being graded, drained, paved and otherwise improved, and hereby agrees that the use of any street or highway for parking within an interchange area will not at any time be permitted; and

Section 3. That the City hereby agrees to adopt or pass such legally effective ordinances and/or laws as will permanently barricade and/or relocate certain intersecting streets as required by the State and to permanently deny or limit access at certain locations as required by the State along said improvements, all of which are more specifically stated in the Project Notes (Sheets 2E-2F), General Traffic Plan Notes

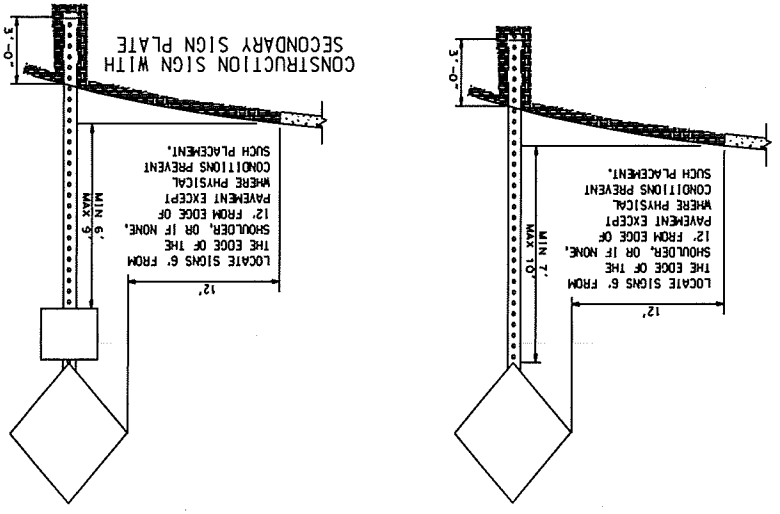

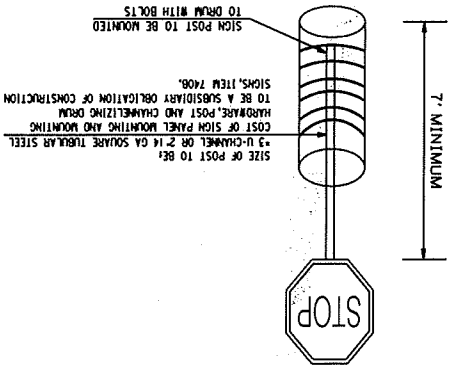

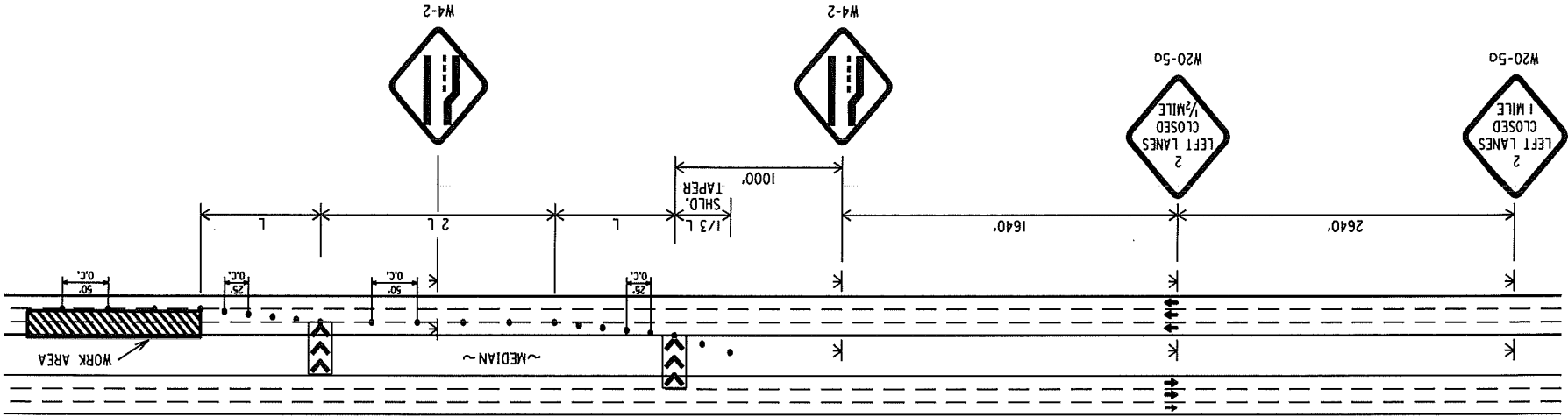

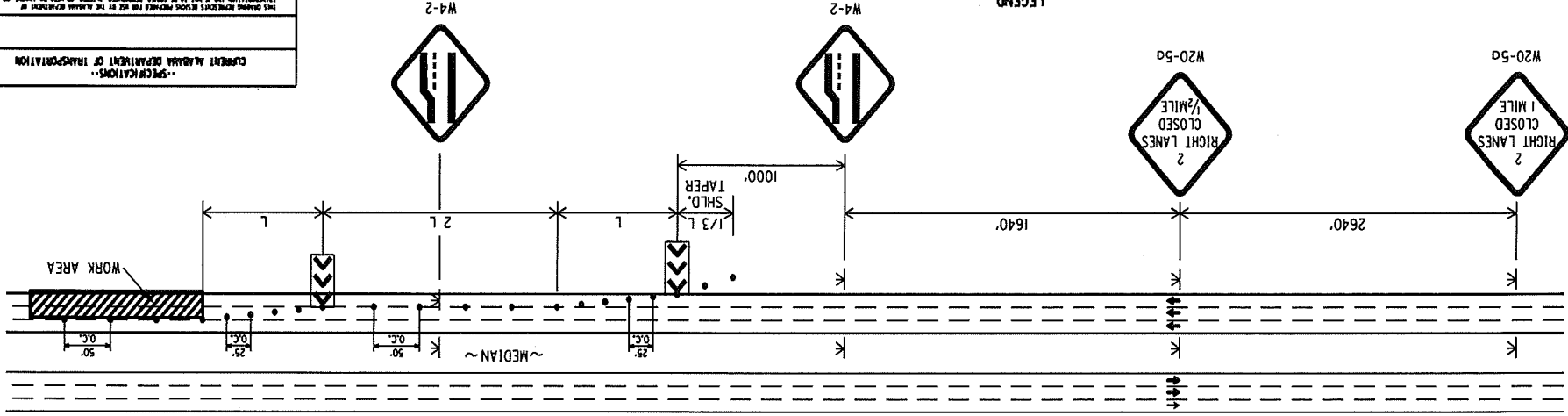

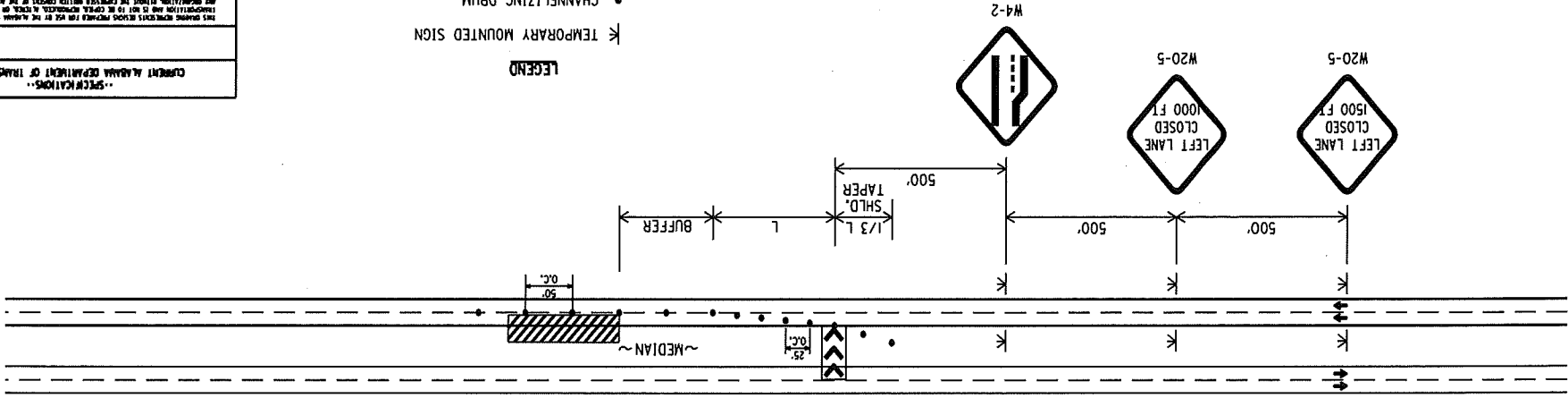
TYPICAL SCHEME FOR RIGHT LANE CLOSURE

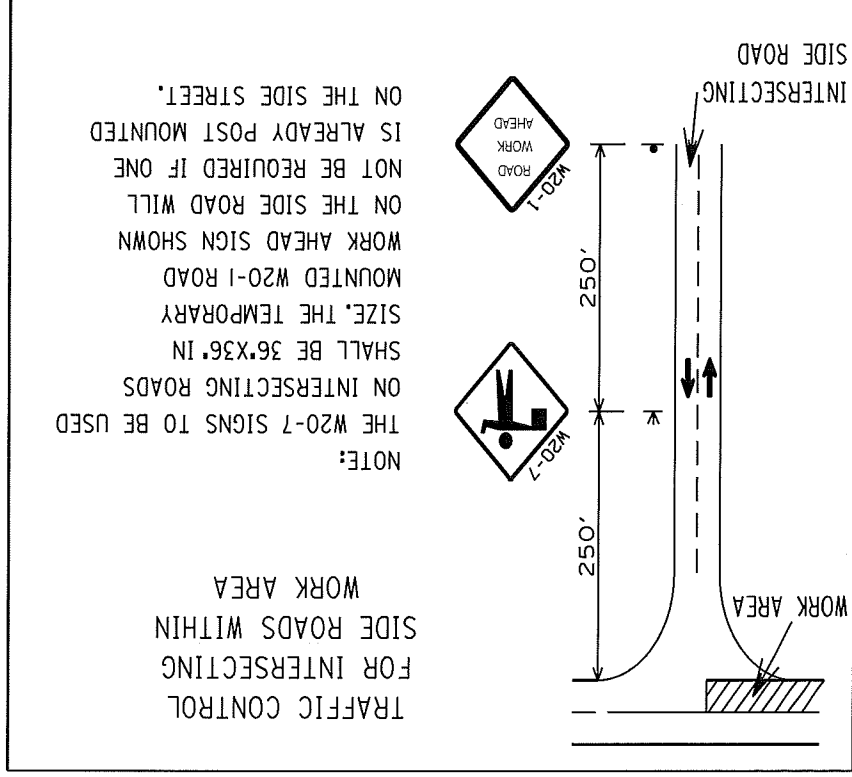

(2H-2I), Traffic Signal Plan Notes (2G) & Traffic Control Plan Summary Sheets (Sheets 6-14) contained within the NH-0079(518) report (**Exhibit 1**); and

Section 4. That for and consideration of ADOT in cooperation with the FHA, constructing said highway and routing traffic along the same through the City over said project, the City hereby agrees with the ADOT and for the benefit of the FHA, that on the above mentioned project the City will not in the future permit encroachments upon the right of way; nor will it pass any ordinances or laws fixing a speed limit contrary to those limits provided in Title 32, Chapter 5, Code of Alabama 1975, as amended, (“Title 32”) and other laws of Alabama; nor will it permit other than parallel parking in areas where parking is permitted; nor will it allow the placing of any informational, regulatory, or warning signs, signals, median crossover, curb and pavement or other markings, and traffic signals without written approval of the ADOT and the FHA, of the location, form and character of such installations. The traffic control devices and signs installed during construction, and those installed after completion of this project shall be in accordance with the latest edition of the national Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices and accepted standards adopted by the ADOT and by the FHA. The City further agrees that subsequent traffic control devices deemed necessary by it in keeping with applicable statutes, rules and regulations to promote the safe and efficient utilization of the highway under the authority of Title 32 and all other applicable laws of Alabama, shall be subject to and must have the approval of the ADOT and of the FHA, prior to the installation and the City further agrees that it will enforce traffic and control the same under the provisions of Title 32, and other applicable laws of Alabama.

Section 5. That the City agrees to perform maintenance on the following:

1. Crossroads, service drives, or relocated roads that are not designated federal or state highways that are in the jurisdiction of the City;
2. Any existing road which has been replaced by a new road; or, if the existing road is not used, the City has the option of vacating same;
3. Interchanges to the theoretical crossing of the denied access line; and
4. Grade separations along the roadway to the end of the bridge, or the denied access fence, whichever the case.

It is understood and agreed that no changes in this Resolution or Agreement shall in the future be made without having obtained the prior approval of the FHA.

Under public petitions & communications, Tarrant resident Jacqueline Rice of 2077 Lane Avenue asked the Council to consider once again her relief request regarding the grass and weeds lien on her 2017 ad valorem bill. Discussion ensued. Councilors asker her questions regarding her taxes, her fire-damaged property, homeowners insurance and plans for cleaning up the fire-damaged remains. The Council chose not to consider her request. Tarrant residents Nathaniel Van Horn (owner) of 1244 Maple Street & Harriet Van Horn Austin (mother & neighbor) asked the Council to void the grass and weeds lien on his 2017 ad valorem bill. Discussion ensued. Councilors asked them questions about their ownership history and plans for paying off the accumulated charges.

Whereupon, Horton introduced the following resolution:

RESOLUTION NO. 8411

**A RESOLUTION VOIDING A GRASS & WEED LIEN ON A TARRANT
PROPERTY OWNER'S 2017 AD VALOREM BILL FOR THE PURPOSES
OF ACCEPTING SETTLEMENT**

WHEREAS, after enacting Resolution No. 8346, the City of Tarrant (“the City”) referred various grass & weed charges to the Jefferson County Tax Collector to be attached as liens, and

WHEREAS, one of those parcels accumulated \$1500 in unpaid grass & weed charges under a previous owner, and

WHEREAS, the owner of a parcels has made a reasonable offer to the City to settle properly levied grass & weeds charges.

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Tarrant, Alabama while in regular

session on Wednesday, January 3rd, 2018 at 7:00 pm as follows:

Section 1. That said resolution is hereby amended, and the lien referenced below is voided, so that no assessment shall be due:

Section 2. A copy of said resolution shall be forwarded to the current owner, Nathaniel Van Horn.

Section 3. The City Clerk shall prepare delivery of this resolution releasing the lien upon initial payment of \$300 to the City.

Section 4. The property owner shall agree to enter an agreement on a promissory note to pay the remaining \$723.04 in ad valorem taxes.

Section 5. Harriet Van Horn Austin and Nathaniel Van Horn agree to be personally liable for the remaining \$1200 balance on grass and weeds charges. Furthermore, they agree to make monthly payments of at least \$100 (minimum), due on the 15th of every month starting February 2018, until paid off. In the event of default, the balance due along with a six percent (6%) interest rate will become due immediately. If the full defaulted amount remains unpaid, the City will attach that amount to the next ad valorem bill. Van Horn shall agree not to contest the defaulted debt getting attached to the ad valorem bill.

Section 6. Van Horn & Austin promise to secure payment by pledging the property located at 1244 Maple Street, Tarrant Alabama 35217.

Section 7. Upon execution of said promissory note, a copy of this resolution shall also be forwarded to the Jefferson County Tax Collector for the purposes of voiding the grass and weed lien portion of the 2017 ad valorem tax bill for the aforementioned parcel.


