CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TARRANT, ALABAMA ORDINANCE NO. 1140

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TARRANT, ALABAMA, AMENDING CHAPTER 4, ARTICLE I, SECTION 4-4 OF THE CITY CODE, ADOPTING CODES SETFORTH BY THE INTERNATIONAL CODE COUNCIL RELATING TO INSPECTION ACTIVITES AND ENFORCEMENT OF BUILDING PROVISIONS FOR THE CITY OF TARRANT.

Whereas, it is the desire of the City Council of the City of Tarrant to adopt, in all respects, the various International Code Council (ICC) codes relating to building, residential, electrical, gas, mechanical, and plumbing; and

Whereas, the adoption of these Codes is done to facilitate proper inspections activities by the City of Tarrant relating to construction of buildings within the corporate limits of said city and relating to public safety, health and general welfare;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Tarrant on December 6, 2021, at 7 p.m.:

<u>Section 1.</u> Section 4-4 of the City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 4-4. Technical codes – Adopted by reference.

Codes are for the 2021 Edition:

- (1) 2021 ICC International Building Code (IBC)
- (2) 2021 ICC International Residential Code (IRC)
- (3) 2021 ICC International Mechanical Code (IMC)
- (4) 2021 ICC International Plumbing Code (IPC)
- (5) 2021 ICC International Fuel Gas Code (IFGG)
- (6) 2021 ICC International Energy Conservation Code (IECC)
- (7) 2021 ICC International Existing Building Code (IEBC)
- (8) 2021 ICC International Wildland Urban Interface Code (IWUIC)
- (9) 2021 ICC International Performance Code for Buildings and Facilities (ICCPC)
- (10) 2021 ICC International Property Maintenance Code (IPMC)
- (11) 2021 ICC International Zoning Code (IZC)
- Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its adoption, as otherwise provided by law.

Section 3. If any provision of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person, thing, or circumstances, is held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect the provisions or application, and to this end, the provisions of this code and such amendment and statutes are declared to be severable.

Section 4. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be included and incorporated in the Code of Ordinance of the City of Tarrant as an addition or amendment thereto, and shall be appropriately renumbered as necessary to conform to the uniform numbering system of the code.

ORDINANCE NO. 1141

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TARRANT, ALABAMA, AMMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1137 TO REMOVE THE REQUIREMENT FOR FACIAL COVERINGS IN CITY OF TARRANT BUILDINGS.

WHEREAS, on August 2nd, 2021, the City Council of the City of Tarrant enacted City of Tarrant Ordinance no. 1137 to require the wearing of face coverings in all City of Tarrant buildings in response to the heightened public health risks associated with rising cases of COVID-19, and especially the Delta Variant;

WHEREAS, strides have been made in the availability of COVID-19 vaccination, with only 43.4% of Alabamians having received a COVID-19 vaccine on August 2nd, and over 55% having received a COVID-19 vaccine at the time of this meeting;

WHEREAS, the state public health emergency declared by Governor Kay Ivey on August 13th, 2021, expired on October 31st, 2021;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 11-43-81 of the *Code of Alabama* (1975), the Mayor has "general supervision and control over all other officers and affairs of the city or town, except as otherwise provided [by law];"

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article I, Sec. 2-1 of the *Tarrant Code of Ordinances*, "The mayor shall prescribe rules, not inconsistent with the laws of the state or the ordinances of the city, for regulating the distribution and performance of all business of the city, and for the regulation of officers and employees under such official's control;"

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TARRANT AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The wearing of facial coverings in City of Tarrant Buildings is at the discretion of the individual.

<u>Section 2.</u> Department heads may continue to implement appropriate dress requirements as needed for the safe performance of job duties, and these requirements may include facial coverings where necessary.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SUBMIT A 2022 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT ("CDBG") PROJECT APPLICATION TO THE JEFFERSON COUNTY COMMISSION AND AUTHORIZING A MATCH AMOUNT UP TO \$175,000 FOR PURCHASE OF NEW FIRE ENGINE FOR THE CITY OF TARRANT FIRE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the Jefferson County Commission is accepting applications for eligible projects for the 2022 Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") Program Cycle; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tarrant is a member of the Jefferson County Consortium and is eligible to submit community development projects for consideration under the CDBG program; and

WHEREAS, although the City of Tarrant has several community development needs that meet the criteria for CDBG funding, it has been determined by the City Council that the purchase of a new fire engine for the City of Tarrant Fire Department is of utmost priority; and

WHEREAS it is understood that the purchase of a new fire engine for the City of Tarrant Fire Department may exceed the amount of funding received from the CDBG program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY a regular session of the City Council of the City of Tarrant, Alabama on the 6th day of December, 2021 as follows:

Section 1: That the Mayor is hereby authorized to file on behalf of the City of Tarrant, Alabama, a 2022 Community Development Block Grant Application listing the purchase of a new fire engine for the City of Tarrant Fire Department as a priority.

LET IT BE FURTHER RESOLVED, that should the purchase of a new fire engine be approved, the City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to fully fund any required matching amounts over the CDBG award, up to \$175,000 for the purchase of said fire engine, out of the City of Tarrant General Fund.

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE <u>DIVISION "G" MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL</u> <u>HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN</u>, IN FULFILLMENT OF THE FEDERAL DISASTER MITIGATION ACT OF 2000 AND THE LOCAL MITIGATION PLAN REQUIREMENTS OF THE 44 C.F.R. SECTION 201.6

WHEREAS, The Federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000, (DMA 2000) as administered by the Alabama Emergency Management Agency and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) provides Federal assistance to local governments to alleviate suffering and damage from disasters, and broadens existing relief programs to encourage disaster preparedness plans and programs, coordination and responsiveness, insurance coverage, and hazard mitigation measures; and,

WHEREAS, as a prerequisite for Alabama Division "G" counties to continue to qualify for FEMA mitigation grant assistance programs, the DMA 2000 requires the plan to be updated every five years and,

WHEREAS, the Division "G" Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan has been updated in accordance with FEMA requirements at 44 C.F.R 201.6. See **EXHIBIT A** for Memorandum of Understanding; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tarrant understands that the adoption of this plan determines the eligibility for Local, State and Federal grant funding that could become available before, during or after a disaster occurs within their jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tarrant participated in updating, the Division "G" Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tarrant is a local unit of government that has afforded the citizens an opportunity to comment and provide input in the plan and actions in the plan; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tarrant has reviewed the plan and affirms that the plan will be updated no less than every five years; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the <u>Division "G" Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation</u> <u>Plan</u> is hereby adopted and is immediately made effective.

Dear Mayor and Council:

The Alabama County Commission Association (ACCA) has awarded regional debris removal and monitoring services contracts. The ACCA Joint Bid Program establishes pre-negotiated contracts that prevent the burden of local governments having to bid these contracts during the trauma caused by a disastrous event. This program provides any municipality within their county the ability to engage these contractors without having to go through the bid process if the municipality has an executed Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with their respective county.

Jefferson County will offer this Debris MOU option again to any municipality that wishes to participate. Please understand that this is just an option, municipalities <u>are not obligated</u> to use the pre-negotiated contract and may bid their own contracts for removal and monitoring. If a municipality intends to have this option available to them, the MOU between the municipality and the county must be in place <u>prior to an event</u>.

Please find enclosed a copy of the Debris Memorandum of Understanding (MOU). The Debris Services Package can be found on the ACCA website at http://www.alabamacounties.org/joint-bid-program/debris/. Jefferson County is located in Region 6. MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE JEFFERSON COUNTY COMMISSION AND THE CITY OF TARRANT REGARDING DEBRIS REMOVAL AND MONITORING SERVICES

WHEREAS, Alabama law authorizes counties and municipalities to enter into agreements to provide services to each other under mutually-agreed to terms and conditions; and

WHEREAS, following recent natural disasters in Alabama, all counties have entered into regional pre-event debris removal and monitoring services contracts to have available for each county in the event of a disaster within one or more counties necessitating the need for debris removal; and

WHEREAS, the Invitation to Bid for these regional pre-event contracts included a provision to require the successful bidder to provide services within the jurisdictional limits of a municipality within an activating county if the county and the municipality had entered into a memorandum of understanding allowing the activating county to assume responsibility for debris removal and/or monitoring services on municipal property within the jurisdictional limits of the municipality: and

WHEREAS, these regional county contracts provide that services may be performed within the jurisdictional limits of a municipality within an activating county at the direction of the county if, prior to the disaster warranting the need for debris removal and/or monitoring services, the county and the municipality have entered into a written memorandum of understanding whereby the county agrees to assume responsibility for performing the services necessary for the removal of disaster-related debris from municipal property on behalf of the municipality; and

WHEREAS, Jefferson County is a party to the Region 6 county contracts for debris removal and monitoring services, which contracts provide for debris removal and monitoring services to be provided to the county upon activation under procedures set out in such contracts; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tarrant is not properly equipped to effectively perform debris removal operations in the event of a disaster within its jurisdictional limits, and as such, the county and municipality find it to be in their mutual best interests and to the benefit of the citizens they represent to enter into this memorandum of understanding to allow the county to have debris removal services performed on the municipal property within the jurisdictional limits of the municipality pursuant to the county regional contract for debris removal services and, if necessary, to have such debris removal monitored pursuant to the county regional contract for monitoring services; and

WHEREAS, both the Jefferson County Commission and the Tarrant City Council have adopted resolutions agreeing to enter into this memorandum of understanding between the Jefferson County Commission and the city of Tarrant, which resolutions are attached hereto and incorporated by reference; and

WHEREAS, the Jefferson County Commission and the City of Tarrant, as evidenced by the above referenced resolutions, also agree to the following terms and conditions:

- That this memorandum of understanding shall only apply in the event that, following a disaster
 necessitating debris removal and/or monitoring services, the county has activated the Region 6
 contract for debris removal and/or monitoring services pursuant to procedures set out in said contract.
- 2. That in the event the municipality desires that the county have debris removal and/or monitoring services performed on municipal property within its municipal jurisdictional limits pursuant to this memorandum of understanding, the mayor or other municipal official designated in writing by the Tarrant City Council shall, unless waived by the county commission, send written notice to the county within five calendar days of a disaster necessitating the removal of debris that the municipality desires to have the county perform such services under the terms and conditions set out in the county regional contracts.
- 3. That, upon receipt of such request, the county determines that it can provide those services within the jurisdictional limits of the municipality pursuant to the county regional debris removal and/or monitoring services contracts.
- 4. That the debris removal and/or monitoring services provided to the municipality shall be limited to available contract personnel and equipment not required to meet the needs of the county, and that the judgment of the Jefferson County Commission or its designee shall be final as to the personnel and equipment so available and as to the time of providing such services.
- 5. That the county shall only provide services within the jurisdictional limits of the municipality that are provided for in the regional county debris removal and monitoring services contracts as set out in the contracts, and such terms are herein incorporated by reference.
- 6. That the City of Tarrant shall cooperate with county and contract personnel as necessary to ensure proper management and administration of the removal of debris within the jurisdictional limits of the municipality pursuant to the regional county contracts for debris removal and/or monitoring services, which cooperation shall include, but not be limited to, allowing county personnel and their contractors access as necessary to perform debris removal and/or monitoring services as determined necessary and appropriate by county personnel and assisting as necessary to provide documentation required under the county regional joint debris removal and/or monitoring services contracts.
- 7. That the municipality understands that monitoring of the debris removal may be necessary and agrees to cooperate with all debris removal monitoring services conducted within its jurisdictional limits pursuant to the county regional monitoring services contract or as otherwise provided by the county.
- 8. That there shall be no debris removal and/or monitoring services performed on private property under this memorandum of understanding and that only services authorized under the regional county contracts as determined by the Jefferson County Commission or its designated county personnel shall be provided.

- 9. That the county may suspend or terminate the removal of debris and/or monitoring services within the jurisdictional limits of the municipality as it deems appropriate or necessary due to (a) conditions within the county; (b) issues related to the regional county contracts for debris removal and/or monitoring; (c) lack of cooperation from municipal officials and/or employees; or (d) other reasons as warranted in the discretion of the county.
- 10. That by entering into this memorandum of understanding, the county assumes no liability for damages to any property of the municipality or any citizens of the municipality resulting from the debris removal or monitoring services conducted by the debris removal or monitoring services contractor. Additionally, the undersigned municipality shall indemnify and hold harmless Jefferson County, its officials, employees, and agents for any damage of any type whatsoever to the municipality's property or to personal property and fixtures situated thereon, or for bodily injury or death to persons on the municipality's property, and hereby releases, discharges and waives any and all actions, either legal or equitable, which the undersigned municipality has, or ever might or may have, by reason of any action of the county and its county officials, employees or debris removal or monitoring services contractors and any action they have taken to accomplish the aforementioned purpose.
- 11. That, unless alternative arrangements are made between the county and municipality prior to the county providing the municipality with debris removal and/or monitoring services as provided herein, the municipality shall reimburse the Jefferson County Commission for any and all expenses incurred by the county for the removal of debris within the jurisdictional limits of the municipality and/or for monitoring services related to the debris removal pursuant to the reimbursement schedule presented to the municipality by the county at the time the municipality submits its request for services as provided in this memorandum of understanding;
- 12. That the municipality's failure to timely reimburse the county pursuant to the reimbursement schedule presented to the municipality by the county shall be deemed a breach of this memorandum of understanding which shall result in termination of this agreement and any other remedies available to the county under the law.
- 13. That in the event the county receives reimbursement for any or all of its costs related to debris removal and/or monitoring services performed within the municipality's jurisdictional limits from any government or other source or sources, the county shall pay the municipality its pro rata share of such reimbursement within thirty days of receipt by the county provided the municipality has paid in full its portion of the cost of debris removal and/or monitoring services pursuant to the requirements set out in paragraph 11 above. However, if at any time after the county has been reimbursed from any source and has reimbursed the municipality in accordance with this paragraph, it is determined that the debris removal and/or monitoring services were not performed in accordance with such source or sources' debris removal and/or monitoring services laws, rules, regulations or guidance, the municipality shall promptly reimburse the County within 15 days the amount of the reduction of the county's reimbursement from such source related to the debris removal and/or monitoring services performed within the municipalities jurisdictional limits.

- 14. That this agreement only applies in the event the county has activated the regional county contract for debris removal and/or monitoring services and that the county shall not be obligated to provide debris removal and/or monitoring services on municipal property within the jurisdictional limits of the municipality except as specifically provided herein.
- 15. That, except as provided in paragraph 12, this memorandum of understanding shall be in full force and effect from the date it is executed by both parties and continue so long as pre-event contracts for debris removal and/or monitoring services are in effect for Region 6 and Jefferson County is a participating county. Either party may terminate for any reason upon thirty (30) days' notice to the other party.

WHEREAS, state and federal law require employers to provide employees with a work environment free of discrimination, harrassment, and hostility on the basis of employee's membership in certain protected classes; and

WHEREAS, Council Member Tommy Bryant has continued to foster a toxic work envioronment through demeaning, disrespectful, intimidating, harrassing and bullying City of Tarrant citizens and employees despite repeated requests to stop this behavior from City of Tarrant employees, citizens as well as from US citizens from around the country, via verbal, telephone and email communications received at City Hall of the City of Tarrant; and

WHEREAS, Council Member Tommy Bryant repeatedly makes inflammatory, racially insensitive and derogatory remarks during council meetings, insulting and verbally attacking City of Tarrant employees and other officials. Verball attacks have included, bu not limited to calling one person a "pervert" and a "boy" and referring to another as a "pig"; and

WHEREAS, Council Member Tommy Bryant consistently obstructs local government business at the City of Tarrant, by not acknowledging and attending committee meetings, not acknowledging and reviewing information packets prior to schduled meetings, not attending Special Called Council Meetings in hopes of not establishing a quoram and preventing the ability to vote on a Resolution, by walking out of meetings to remove established quorams, and by constantly being disruptive during Council Meetings, completely disregarding the established Rule of Parlimentary Procedures previously established by the City of Tarrant; and

WHEREAS, Council Member Tommy Bryant words and actions have strained relations between the City Council of the City of Tarrant and other elected bodies and citizen groups in our community, running counter to our active efforts to better collaborate and coordinate, ultimately creating negative impacts for the City of Tarrant's employee recruitment and economic and community development efforts; and

- **Section 2**. That the Council fomally asks Council Member John T. "Tommy" Bryant to stop using disgusting and inflamatory language that is either racially and genderly devisive or otherwise harmful to the City of Tarrant's resident, employees, and other officials.
- **Section** 3. That the Council requests that Council Member John T. "Tommy" Bryant work with the City Council of the City of Tarrant rather than obstruct ongoing work and decision/recommendation making processes for the overall good of the city.
