MARCH 6, 2023
TARRANT CITY HALL

The City Council of the City of Tarrant, Alabama, met in a regularly scheduled meeting on Monday, March 6, 2023, at 7:00PM at City Hall.

Mayor Wayman A. Newton called the meeting to order at 7:01PM following the council work session that began at 6:00PM to discuss the items on the agenda and other matters.

Fire Lt. Patrick Bennett led those in attendance in the Pledge of Allegiance. Rev. Webb gave the invocation.

Councilor Threadford moved to appoint Michael Brymer, the city attorney who was present, as the acting city clerk for the meeting. Councilor Anderson seconded the motion. There was no discussion. A voice vote was taken with all present voting in favor, and the motion was agreed to.

Mayor Newton asked for a roll call. The following officials were present during the roll call:

The minutes from the February 20, 2023, regularly scheduled council meeting were presented for review and approval. After review, Councilor Threadford moved to approve the minutes as presented. Councilor Anderson seconded the motion. Mayor Newton called for a roll call vote.

The yeas being six (6) and the nays being zero (0), the motion to approve the minutes as presented were adopted, and the minutes from the February 20, 2023, council meeting were approved.

The following items were communicated from the Mayor's office to those in attendance:

Mayor Newton advised that there had been an increase in the number of dangerous and vicious dog attacks throughout Jefferson County and some inside the City. Because of this increase, the City would begin enforcing the vicious dog ordinance that was enacted in 2002. The Mayor indicated at the next council meeting there would be a presentation on the ordinance and a "grace period" of enforcement would follow in order to ensure adequate notice to the citizens were provided.

Next, the Mayor announced the Easter Egg hunt will be held on April 8, 2023, at Hewitt Park from 11:00AM to 2:00PM. He encouraged all churches and neighborhood associations to attend and set up booths for the event, and that thanks to several donations for the event, no city funds would be expended. More details will follow as time gets closer to the event.

This ended the communications from the Mayor's office.

The Mayor next asked for any communications from the city councilors present.

Councilor Threadford announced she and Councilor Freeman organized a program discussing career opportunities at Tarrant Middle School and Tarrant High School. The students in attendance heard from a veterinarian, law enforcement officer, and the Tarrant Middle School students heard from a nurse about what those careers looked like, and if someone was interested, how they could start preparing for those careers while in school.

This concluded the reports from the city councilors present.

Next, the Mayor recognized Mr. Paul Anthony, a local business owner, who requested time to address the council regarding the potential to lease the former Peoples Bank Building from the City. Mr. Anthony introduced himself, gave an overview of his business, and stated that he wished to relocate his business from his existing building to this new building in order to expand his capacity and for other reasons. The Mayor indicated he would pass this to the Deputy Mayor for further discussion and negotiations with Mr. Anthony.

Next, the City Council heard from members of the public who had signed in to speak prior to the meeting.

First, Mr. Chuck Winborn addressed the council regarding his impressions having recently been appointed to serve on the Tarrant Citizen Crime Commission. Mr. Winborn stated the commission members recently toured the jail. During the jail tour, it was observed that the paint in the men's shower was coming up and needed to be repainted and resealed. Mr. Winborn also inquired about the possibilities of having some of the crime commission members and city councilors attend conflict resolution training.

Second, Rev. Webb addressed the council thanking the mayor and the council for allowing citizens to speak their minds on issues and matters pending before the council.

Third, Mr. Jason Weinstein, owner of 1141 Pinson St., addressed the council regarding items had had satisfied following the receipt of a notice of violation from Mr. Caisin and Lt. Bennett as fire marshal. Mr. Weinstein has completed all items contained on the notice that addresses Mr. Caisin's and Lt. Bennett's concerns. There was one (1) matter that remained regarding the removal of some protective fencing / barbed wire around a patio area that was communicated from Mr. Caisin to

Mr. Weinstein by way of Lt. Bennett. Mr. Caisin has apparently requested the protective fencing and barbed wire remove. Mr. Weinstein indicated the fencing and barbed wire had been there before he had purchased the building, which is the old American Legion building. Mr. Weinstein requested he not have to remove the protective fencing or barbed wire since it predated him and because it would cause undue hardship by subjecting the building on the property to potential burglary and theft of its contents.

Fourth, Ms. Winifried Dill of the Brumitt Heights community stated that of the trucks traveling to and from the Green Valley Landfill, 100% of those trucks pass her home and cause issues. Ms. Dill remains supportive of any efforts to remove the trucks from the roadway.

Fifth, Mr. Charles Johnson of the Brumitt Heights community stated he doesn't want a dump in the neighborhood and respects the City of Tarrant and Councilor Freeman. Mr. Johnson announced there will be a neighborhood meeting regarding the landfill variance request on March 19, 2023, at 3:00PM at Lily Baptist Church with a landfill tour afterwards.

Sixth, Ms. Escott addressed the council regarding the discharging of firearms within the corporate limits. She indicated there has been a significant increase in the number of firearms being discharged. The Mayor called upon Chief of Police Major to address this issue. Chief Major reiterated that it is a misdemeanor to discharge a fireman inside the corporate limits, and the police would do their best to respond, apprehend, and charge anyone they could. Officers are responding after being called from dispatch, but upon arriving at the scene, the officers can smell the gun powder, but anyone in the area denies seeing anything or knowing who discharged the firearm. Because the charge is a misdemeanor, the officer would have to witness the act of discharging the weapon before he or she can perfect an arrest under state law. Chief Major encouraged citizens to stop discharging their firearms and requested assistance from anyone in these areas upon TPD responding to the areas.

This concluded comments from the public.

Councilor Freeman then asked the Mayor about when a replacement stop sign could be expected at the corner of Waverly Avenue and Hillcrest Avenue. Mayor Newton stated he sent the request to public works who has ordered the stop sign. Councilor Freeman stated it had been almost two (2) weeks since the stop sign was missing, and that she had completed an incident report with TPD regarding the missing stop sign.

Finally, the council considered the vouchers and expenses of the city. Prior to moving to approve the vouchers and expenses, several city councilors questioned the mayor regarding some of the expenses shown. After much discussion, Councilor Threadford moved to approve the vouchers and expenses as presented. Councilor Anderson seconded the motion. Mayor Newton called for a vote.

A RESOLUTION TO RESCIND RESOLUTION 8998 GRANTING LIMITED LICENSE FOR GREEN VALLEY SERVICES TO ENTER CITY OWNED PROPERTY FOR THE PURPOSE OF SURVEYING A POTENTIAL ROADBED.

WHEREAS, on March 6, 2023, the City Council passed Resolution 8998 granting Green Valley Services a limited license to enter City-owned property for the purpose of surveying a potential road bed; and

WHEREAS, since that time new information has been presented to from Freshwater Land Trust regarding the City Council's ability to grant such license (said information is attached hereto as Exhibit A); and

WHEREAS, in deference to this new information, it is necessary to rescind Resolution 8998 and revoke the limited license granted to Green Valley Services to enter said property.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Tarrant, Alabama while in regular session on Monday, March 20, 2023 as follows:

1. That the preamble and attachment(s) are adopted and incorporated as if fully set forth herein.
2. That Resolution 8999 is hereby rescinded and all permissions and/or license granted under said resolution are hereby revoked.

Subject: Notice from Freshwater Land Trust regarding Freshwater Land Trust Property in Tarrant - PLEASE READ IMMEDIATELY.

Michael, Charlie, and Mayor Newton,

I am writing this e-mail to all of you regarding a parcel of land owned by Freshwater Land Trust (FLT) that I, along with Liz Sims, our Land Conservation Director, learned yesterday was placed on Tarrant's March 6th City Council Regular Meeting Agenda, specifically New Business Resolution Nos. 8997 and 8998, which were tabled until March 10, 2023. As you know, we have had previous conversations and e-mail exchanges with each of you about the circumstances surrounding this property. However, for clarification, I am sending this e-mail, so we are all on the same page with the same understanding of Freshwater Land Trust's position at to its property.

In 2017, FLT transferred roughly 500 acres of property to Tarrant as a match for funding for a flood mitigation project pursuant to a statutory warranty deed (Instrument #201727681). In order for Tarrant to maximize the value of the property for the grant match, FLT removed the restrictive covenants that were placed on the property when FLT originally acquired it as part of the Jefferson County Greenway Project. Pursuant to the attached February 22, 2016, MOA between FLT and Tarrant (as well as attached MOA amendments), Tarrant agreed to put perpetual restrictive covenants on the property when it received the property from FLT, which Tarrant did in 2017 (Instrument #2017128655). FLT's original restrictive covenants and Tarrant's perpetual restrictive covenants restrict, among other things, the activity requested in the two aforementioned resolutions. FLT is also a named third-party enforcer of Tarrant's perpetual restrictive covenants.

In addition, the statutory warranty deed contains a reversionary clause in favor of FLT, stating that if Tarrant did not complete the flood mitigation project by December 31, 2019, it would revert to FLT. However, the statutory warranty deed did allow for extension(s) and amendment(s) to the deed if requested from and approved by FLT. Accordingly, one-year amendments were requested, approved, and filed in 2019 (Instrument #2019134438) and 2020 (Instrument #2020148789), respectively, allowing Tarrant additional time to complete the flood mitigation project. Tarrant did not request another extension/amendment from FLT on or before December 31, 2021. Therefore, in accordance with the statutory warranty deed, the property reverted to FLT on January 1, 2022, which we have discussed with all of you previously. FLT agreed to hold off on filing a formal affidavit regarding the reversion to give Tarrant additional time to secure funding and complete the flood mitigation project.

As we also discussed with Michael, FLT filed a title affidavit (Instrument #2023008646) on February 1, 2023, to correct a scrivener's error in the property description discovered in the statutory warranty deed.

In April of last year, Charlie Waldrep reached out to FLT to discuss putting a permeable surfaced road across the property to service the existing C&D landfill. At that time, we informed Charlie that FLT owned the property, and, on April 26, 2022, we e-mailed him a copy of the original FLT restrictive covenants and the 2019 and 2020 amendments. We told Charlie that, in our opinion, the restrictive covenants prohibited the requested road. Charlie subsequently reached out to one of FLT's board members, who also happens to be an attorney and the Chair of FLT's Land Committee. That board member reiterated FLT's position and invited Charlie to make a formal presentation to FLT's board for consideration, which was never done. To my knowledge, no other FLT board member was ever contacted about it.

In summary, please note that New Business Resolution Nos. 8997 and 8998 requesting permission to reduce the buffer for the landfill and to provide a license to the landfill for ingress and egress incorrectly identifies Tarrant as the property owner, since the property reverted to FLT on January 1, 2022. Moreover, FLT's board would have to make any such decision after a formal request, which, again, has not been done. Accordingly, no further action should be taken on FLT's property until such time.

WHEREAS, Tarrant Emergency Dispatch and the Tarrant Police Department have recently contracted with E-Force to provide services regarding law enforcement data retention and reporting; and

WHEREAS, during the recent implementation of said E-Force software, it was discovered that E-Force does not include an interface with existing Fire Department ERS or Active911 services; and

WHEREAS, to correct this inadequacy and allow CAD information to interface with Fire Department ERS, an additional link must be built; and

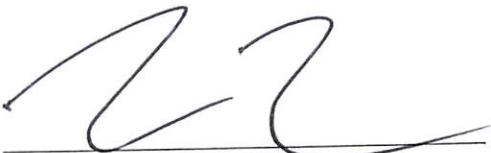
WHEREAS, the total cost of the proposed interface is E-Force software is \$7,295 for initial implementation, plus an annual service fee of \$1,020 per year. Implementation costs as broken down as follows and are attached hereto: E-Force - \$6,800.00 (plus annual service fee); ESO - \$495.00.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Tarrant, Alabama while in regular session on Monday, March 20, 2023 as follows:

1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to expend an additional \$7,295.00 for the creation of an E-Force CAD call information interface to integrate dispatch with existing Fire Department emergency reporting software, plus an additional \$1,020.00 per year for annual service fees.
2. That said expenditures are eligible E-911 fund expenses and shall be paid as stated above from same.

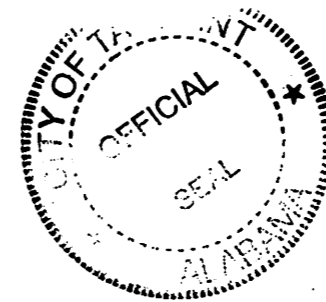
