SEPTEMBER 6, 2023
TARRANT CITY HALL

The City Council of the City of Tarrant, Alabama, met in a regularly scheduled meeting on Wednesday September 6, 2023, at 7:00PM at City Hall.

Mayor Wayman A. Newton called the meeting to order at 7:03PM following the council work session that began at 6:00PM to discuss items on the agenda and other matters.

Tarrant City Elder Johnson from Messiah's House lead those in attendance in the invocation. Fire Chief Patrick Bennett lead those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes from the August 21, 2023 regularly scheduled council meeting were presented for review and approval. After review, Councilor Bryant moved to approve the minutes from August 21, 2023, meeting as presented. Councilor Mathews seconded the motion. Mayor Newton called for a roll call vote.

The Mayor informed those in attendance that Deputy Mayor, Lisa Baker, had a few things to present. The following items were presented from the Mayor's office to those in attendance:

Deputy Mayor Lisa Baker informed all who were present that the storm shelter, its location and its initial drawings have finally been approved by the Engineer of Special Architect of Jefferson County. Concrete pad already formed near the Recreation Center. Possible that construction will begin within the next few months.

Mayor and Council were provided with a hard copy spreadsheet list of houses that will tentatively be demolished. Deputy Mayor Lisa Baker also provided overall summary on some houses that will be demolished via grant assistance. Title work search done and needed on some of the homes with results not yet returned for some of the homes.

Deputy Mayor Lisa Baker informed all who were present that a request for Qualifications for the City Engineer for the City of Tarrant is needed. Several Federal Grants are approaching that need to be applied for. Any federal grant requires one to procure an engineer. They won't take a city hired engineer. In past pre-engineering had to be complete and paid for. Though front costs are still needed some of the new infrastructure money will be eligible for reimbursement. Request for qualifications for the engineer also lowers the rate of what an engineer charges and the engineer will only get paid for what is being done. Also will be helpful to have the engineer for some of the projects (ex. Roads, flood litigation etc.).

Stop signs for some of the intersections in Tarrant approved and already installed. Will get with the Chief to develop more planning on more stop signs to regulate and monitor traffic in the City of Tarrant.

Mayor Newton also asked Allen Pilkington to provide update on City of Tarrant 1st Football home game of 2023 Tail gate event. Mr. Pilkington informed all who were present that the a community tailgate event will occur an hour before kick off to show support on September 8, 2023.

Mayor Newton informed all who were present that there will be a 'Fourth Friday on Ford' event held on September 22, 2023 to celebrate Hispanic Heritage month. Everyone is invited to attend this Fiesta event from 6:00PM to 9:00PM.

This ended the communications from the Mayor's office.

The Mayor next asked for any communications from the city councilors present.

Council Freeman informed all who were present of a traffic light concern in the intersection of Tarrant Huffman Road and Treadwell Road. Though the intersection is not located in the City of Tarrant, Councilor Freeman asked the Mayor to communicate with Jefferson County and City of Birmingham Authorities for the purpose of addressing the need for a traffic light in the said intersection. Councilor Freeman agreed on a proposed Resolution to be drafted authorizing the Mayor to communicate and possibly split costs with Jefferson County Commission and the City of Birmingham for installation of traffic lights at the said intersection, with Attorney involvement after informal agreement made between the three official parties.

Council Freeman informed all who were present that she is still blocked from the City of Tarrant Facebook page since June 6, 2023.

The Mayor then called for committee reports.

RESOLUTION NO. 9049

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO NEGOTIATE WITH THE CITY OF BIRMINGHAM AND JEFFERSON COUNTY FOR THE PLACEMENT OF A TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICE AT THE INTERSECTION OF TARRANT-HUFFMAN ROAD AND TREADWELL ROAD.

WHEREAS, § 11-45-1 of the Code of Alabama (1975), as amended, allows any city to pass ordinances and resolutions for the health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the intersection of Tarrant-Huffman Road and Treadwell Road, which does not lie wholly within the corporate limits of the City of Tarrant ("City") but rather within the corporate limits of the City of Birmingham, and is either maintained by the City of Birmingham or Jefferson County; and

WHEREAS, the residents of the Brummitt Heights community part of which lies within the corporate limits of Tarrant and part within the City of Birmingham have repeatedly voiced their concerns of their health and safety without the presence of a traffic control device at the above-referenced intersection; and

WHEREAS, because the intersection does not lie wholly within the corporate limits of Tarrant nor is either roadway City maintained road, the placement and installation of a traffic control device at the referenced intersection will require both the City of Birmingham and Jefferson County, as well as potentially other state departments, to become involved; and

WHEREAS, based on prior information conversations and meetings, there may exist a potential to negotiate an agreement for the placement of a traffic control device at the referenced intersection; provided, however, that the City may be willing split or otherwise divide the costs of the installation of the light along with any costs incidental thereto; and

WHEREAS, having heard from its citizens, the City Council of the City of Tarrant ("City Council") find it in the best interest of its citizens to authorize the Mayor to attempt to negotiate any agreement with the City of Birmingham, Jefferson County, and any other necessary entity in order for a traffic control device to be placed at the intersection of Tarrant-Huffinan Road and Treadwell Road in order to address the concerns of its citizens.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Tarrant, Alabama, while in a regular session on Monday, September 18, 2023 at 7:00 pm as follows:

Section 1. The above-stated preamble is hereby adopted and ratified as if fully set out herein.

Section 2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to begin negotiations with the City of Birmingham, Alabama; Jefferson County, Alabama; and any other necessary entity to discuss the feasibility of and cost sharing agreement, if possible, for the placement of a traffic control device at the intersection of Tarrant-Huffinan Road and Treadwell Road and make routine reports back to the City Council upon the progress of the negotiations.

Section 3. The City Council further agree to expend funds up to but not exceeding \$ _____ as the City's portion toward any cost sharing for the placement of the traffic control device at the referenced intersection.

Section 4. Upon reaching an agreement, the general terms shall be memorialized in a letter of intent or other memorandum with the final agreement subject to the approval of the city council.

Section 5. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

RESOLUTION NO. 9050

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF BASKETBALL GOALS FOR THE CITY OF TARRANT RECREATION CENTER.

WHEREAS, the City of Tarrant, Alabama (“City”) is responsible for maintaining the City of Tarrant Recreation Center (“Rec Center”); and

WHEREAS, the Rec Center is need of replacing its existing basketball goals with updated models to allow for additional practice and game space at the Rec Center during the recreation league season; and

WHEREAS, the City has received a quote from Metro Goals, Inc. (“Metro”) to purchase the basketball goals (see quote attached as “Exhibit A”) in the amount of \$15,886.000; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to section (a) of Act 2023-135 that became effective September 1, 2023, the threshold requiring competitive bids has increased from \$15,000.00 to \$30,000.00, thus eliminating the requirement that this purchase be competitively bid as the quote of \$15,886.00 is under the new threshold of \$30,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City finds it in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of its citizens to authorize the purchase of basketball goals in order to replace the existing basketball goals in the Rec Center.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Tarrant, Alabama while in regular session on Wednesday, September 18, 2023, at 7:00 p.m. as follows:

Section 1. The above-stated preamble is hereby adopted and incorporated as if fully set out herein.

Section 2. The City is hereby authorized to purchase basketball goals for the Rec Center according to the terms in the quote from Metro Goals, Inc. that is attached as Exhibit “A,” and the City is authorized to expend funds in the amount of \$15,886.00 for said purpose which shall be paid from the City’s General Fund.

Section 3. The Mayor or his designee shall be authorized to complete any necessary paperwork and authorization in order to complete the purchase.

Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.

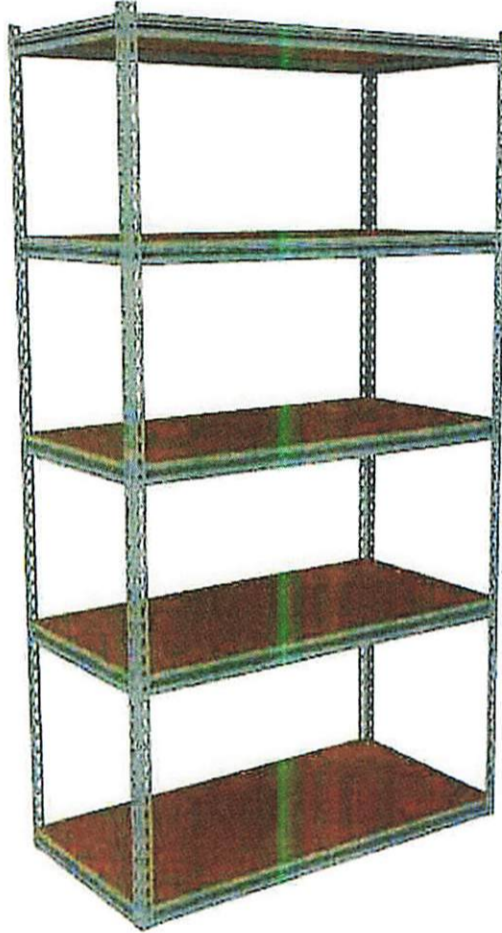
