The Mayor and other officers and employees of the City acting at the direction of the Mayor are hereby authorized to execute any claim forms, pleadings, engagement agreements, waivers, or other documents that may be necessary to preserve the City's interests relative to the matters described herein.

WHEREAS, owners Patrick & Lindy Hartig recently paid \$1000 directly to the City to settle grass and weed charges, which had occurred prior to their ownership
